# Publishing Content



### Enhancements to publication of related pages


Customer's issue

In Management Server when publishing a single page, with 'Publish Related Pages' checked it finds close to 400 'More than 100 affected pages found for <GUID>' and it publishes over 5,000 files

Can take hours before first page is published

- Planned enhancements
  - Observe content changes
  - New publishing options
  - Display content changes and all dependency

# Asset Management



### Support FILESTREAM of SQL Server

 FILESTREAM feature of SQL Server, which allows storage of and efficient access to BLOB data using a combination of SQL Server and the NTFS file system.

#### Benefit

- Publishing performance for large assets
- Decrease IT costs FILESTREAM storage can be HDD and not expensive SSD



  - Date





Use case with Delivery Server: Set validity for assets


- Set dates for "rights to use"
- Publish assets and dates to Delivery Server








